Request Approval for Tournament Date

Written request is to be submitted to Kevin Cote, Head Professional. Upon approval, a non-refundable deposit of \$2,000 is required to secure the date.

Playing Format

For the enjoyment of all players, a Texas Scramble format is recommended. This popular format encourages team competition, is fun and the fastest format of play. This also ensures all players begin and finish play at the same time. Other playing formats will be considered on request.

Tournament Start Time

Tournament start times will be arranged by contacting the Club's General Manager. Based on approval, Tournament play is available on Mondays, Thursdays, and Fridays.

Golf Carts are mandatory for all players and are included in the package price. The Convenor assumes responsibility for all Carts and any damage caused by tournament participants. Carts will be pre-assigned by our Staff upon receipt of the Tournament Convenors pairing sheet.

Cart Riders & Caddies

- Maximum of two golfers per Cart. Three golfers (riders) are not permitted at any time
- Caddies are required to have paid the full entry fee to participate in the tournament and permission is granted by the Tournament Convenor

Public Relations Carts

Public Relations Carts are available at a fee of \$50 inclusive of HST

Property Damage

Should Property Damage occur including window breakage, vehicle damage, or suspected damage to private property adjacent to the Golf Course, including, but not limited to, which caused by the golf ball of a golfer or volunteer participant, the individual person/participant causing the damage is liable for reparation OR by the Tournament Committee/Convenor hosting the event. The participant/guest should provide the owner of the property with their name and phone number, either in person, or by leaving a note in the mailbox of the home. The Golf Shop should be notified of any damage or potential damage, as soon as possible during and/or after completion of the round. It is recommended the Tournament Committee ensures their insurance is adequate to cover such incidents.

Payment Terms

A contract outlining the particulars of the event will be prepared by the Food and Beverage Team for signature by the Tournament Convenor.

A non-refundable deposit of \$2,000 is required upon confirmation of the event date. Payment of the balance based upon the final invoice, is due within seven days of issuance of the final invoice.

Soft Spike Policy

Pointe West Golf Club is a soft spike Club. We are pleased to provide spike conversion services at a nominal cost.

Rain Out

If a rain out occurs prior to the start of play, an alternate date will be arranged subject to Club approval. Ten Holes or more will be considered a completed round.

In the event of a rain out, being 9 Holes or less, dinner will proceed unless alternate arrangements were made between the Tournament Convenor, the Director of Golf, and the Food and Beverage Team, prior to the start of golf. Green Fees will be adjusted through a rain check.

- Tailored Shorts, Skorts, Skirts and Dresses must be no shorter than mid-thigh in length
- Nylon Walking Suits
- Shoes on the Golf Course must be recognized as proper golf footwear

Not Acceptable Attire Includes:

- Tank Tops, Tube Tops and Halter Tops
- Cargo Slacks, Shorts, Skorts and Skirts
- Jackets, Shirts, Slacks, Shorts, Skorts, Skirts and Dresses, or any other wear, of Denim or Jean wear of any colour
- Drawstring Pants or Shorts, Sweat Type Pants, Stirrup Pants, Yoga Pants and Tights
- Hats, Caps or Visors are not to be worn in the Dining Room area

Men's-Dress Code

Acceptable Attire Includes:
